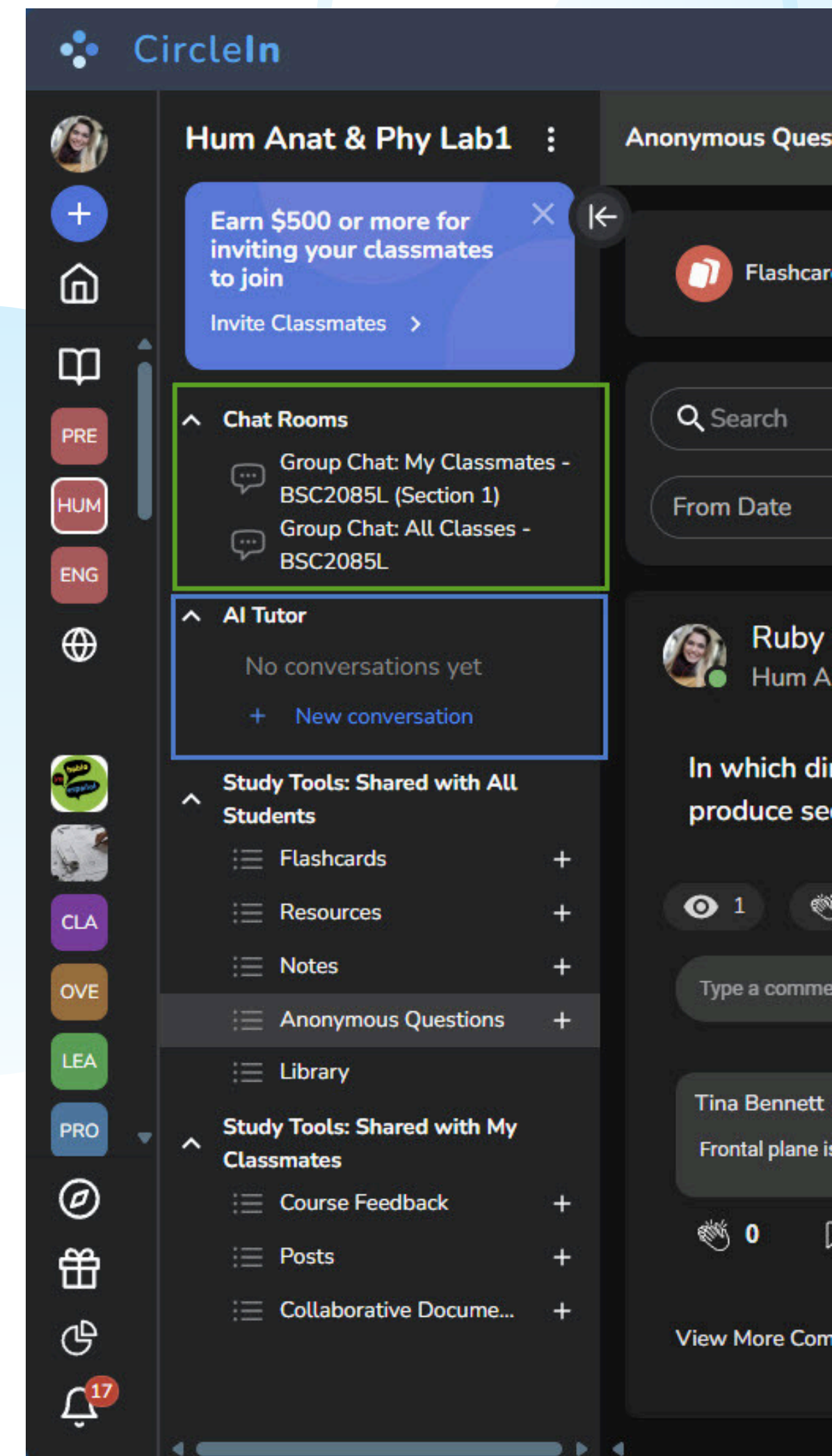
Navigating the Course Outline

CircleIn gives you access to an **optimized group chat** for your course(s) to help you find study material faster, rather than scrolling through chat history to find helpful resources, you can use the course outline to filter specific content, such as flashcards, or notes.

Chat rooms: Access a chat with all students in your section AND another chatroom with all students taking the same course, so you can get or give help to/from the widest possible audience. **Professors by default don't have access to student chats.** They may create an optional "Professor Chat" if they want to engage with you on CircleIn.

(You may also **create smaller private group chats or 1-1 chats** through CircleIn that have dedicated URLs, so you can easily invite select members to join. [This will be covered on Page 9](#))

AI Tutor: Begin asking for help on your homework from our AI Tutor. We won't give you answers, but we will show you how to solve problems on your own which you'll thank us for at test time. (If AI Tutor is not visible in your course outline then the AI Tutor is not available for that specific course.)



AI Tutor

The CircleIn AI Tutor is available 24/7 to help with homework, explain tough concepts, and guide you step-by-step through problems. We won't give you answers, but we'll show you how to solve problems on your own, which you'll thank us for at test time.


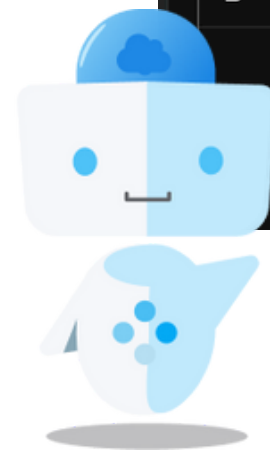

To access the AI Tutor, simply click on one of your courses and you will see the AI Tutor section right under your Chat Rooms. All you have to do is click on "New Conversation" and start chatting with the Tutor!

Small Group Chats & Direct Messages

To create a private group or 1-1 chat, simply access the Messages feature:

On PC: Hover over the far left nav panel and look for “messages” below your course list. Click the “+” symbol to the right to open a new message wizard. Simply type the first and last names of the people you’d like to add.

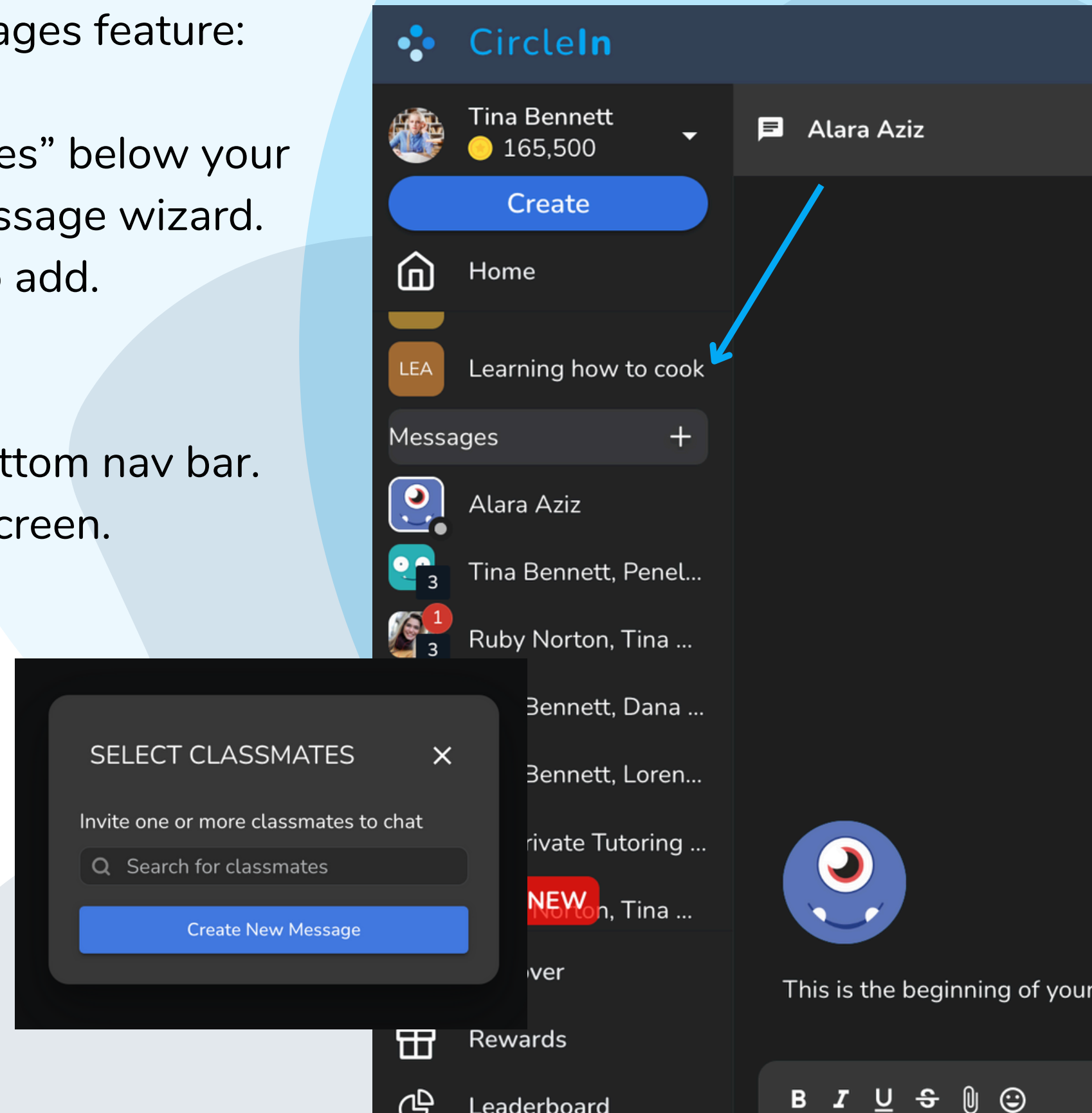
On Mobile: Click the Messages icon on the right side of the bottom nav bar. Then click on the “New Message” icon in the top right of the screen.

Once a group has been established, you can access a dedicated URL that can be emailed or texted to additional students for a convenient way to add additional members.



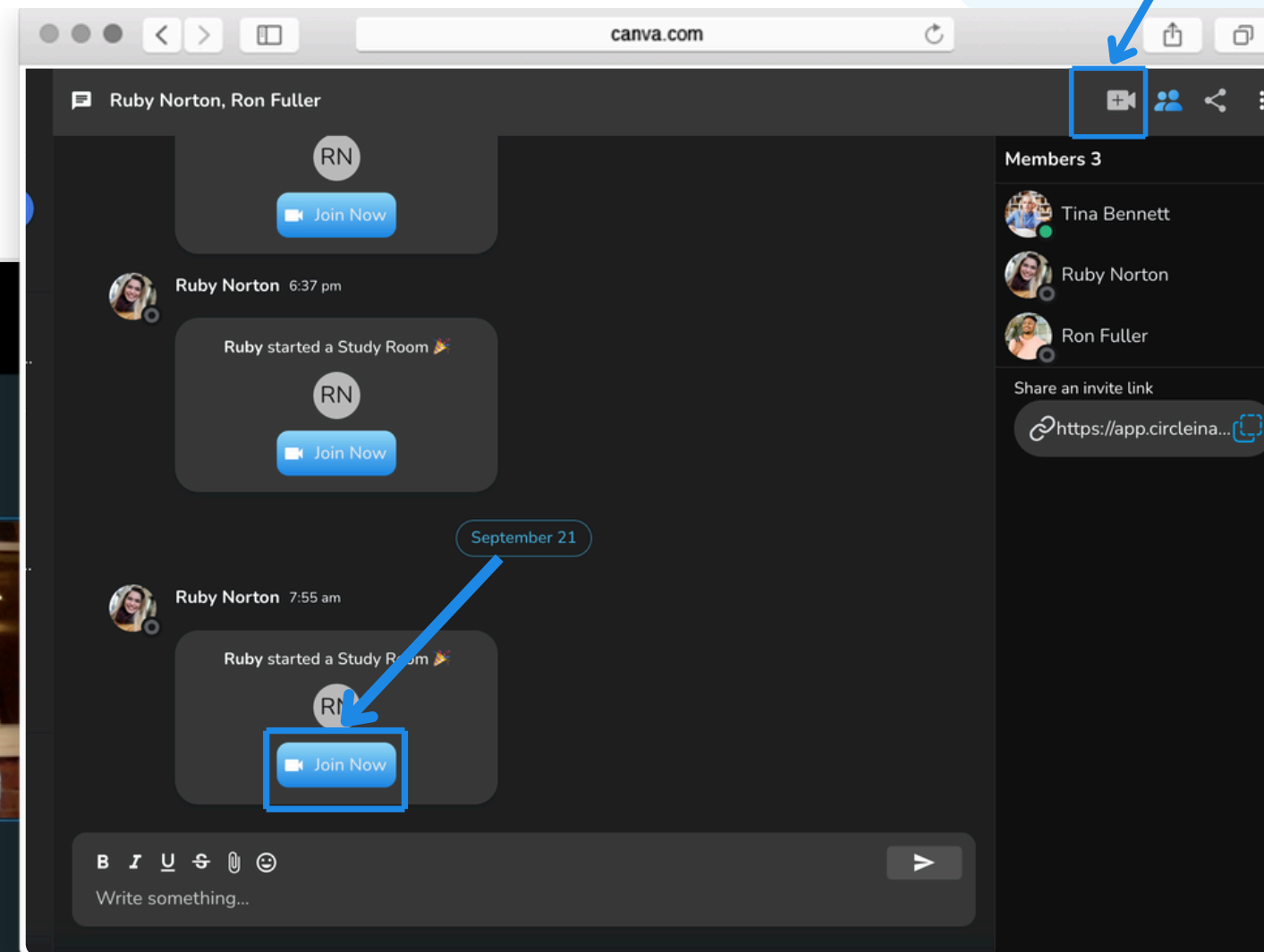

Virtual Study Rooms

Students are able to use Video Chat to further collaborate with classmates and have their own video study session to prepare for upcoming exams or group project assignments!

You may start open a Study Room by clicking on the Camera button in the top right corner of any chat. This feature can be used in direct messages, private groups and class chats as well. When you click the button it will send **all members** of the selected chat room a notification that you've started the room and then they have the option to click to join you.

Share resources: Share helpful weblinks (URLs) with your class.



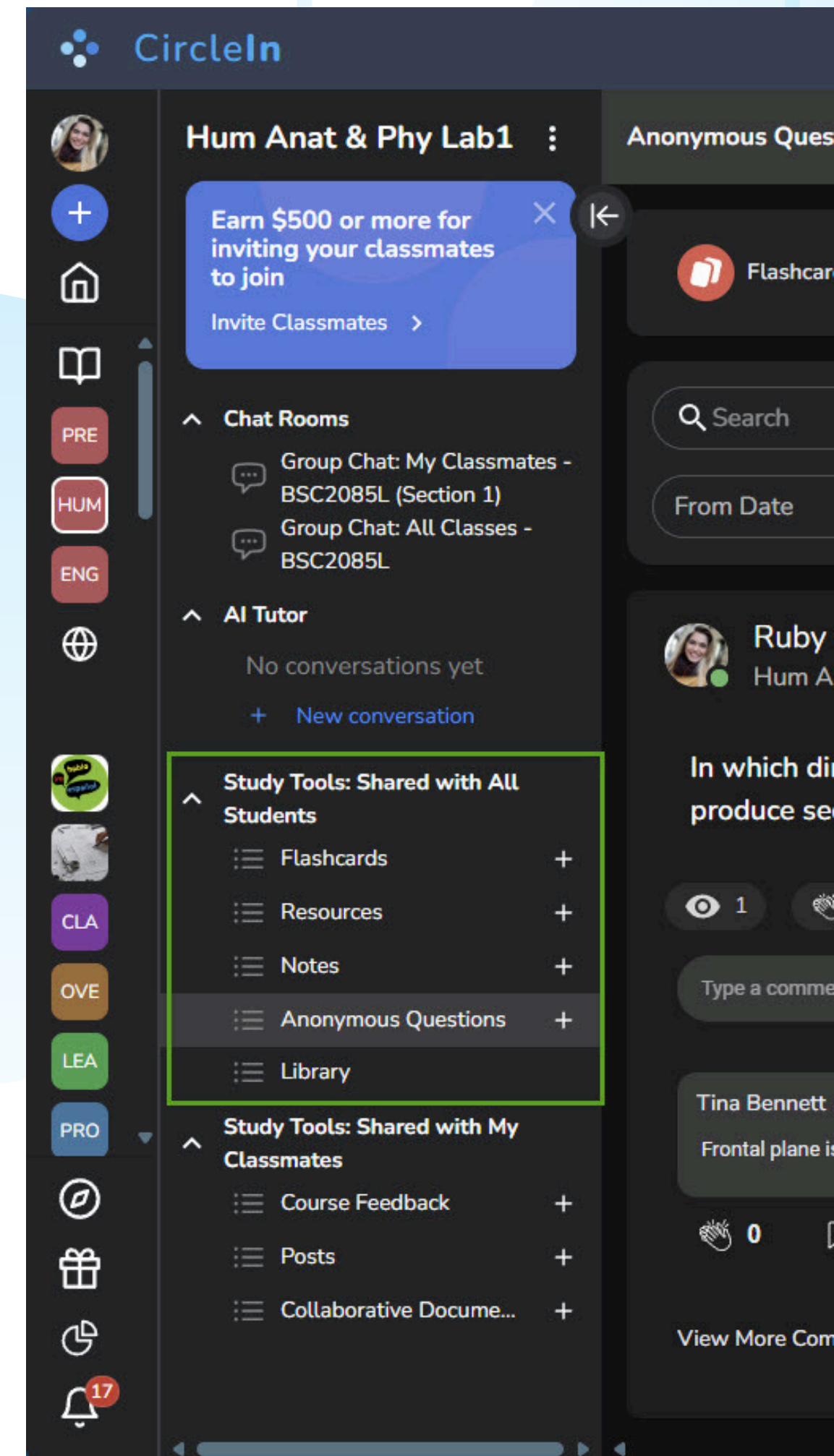

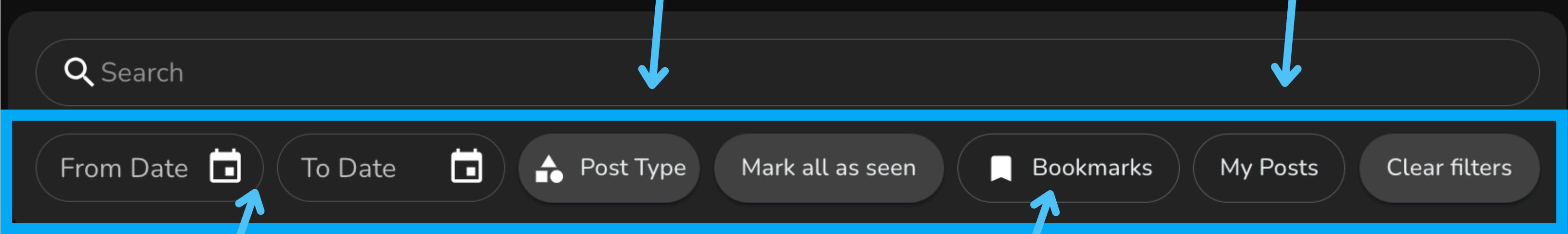

Once a course study feed is selected, students are able to navigate through different views at the top of the feed page. These views are specific to the course selected.

Post Type: You can choose what type of posts you want to see on your feed (Flashcards, Notes, Posts, Resources, Questions)

My Posts: You can review all the posts you have created or shared yourself.



You can also filter by date, clear all filters or mark all posts as seen!

Bookmarks: You can select this view to see all the posts you have bookmarked.

Flashcards

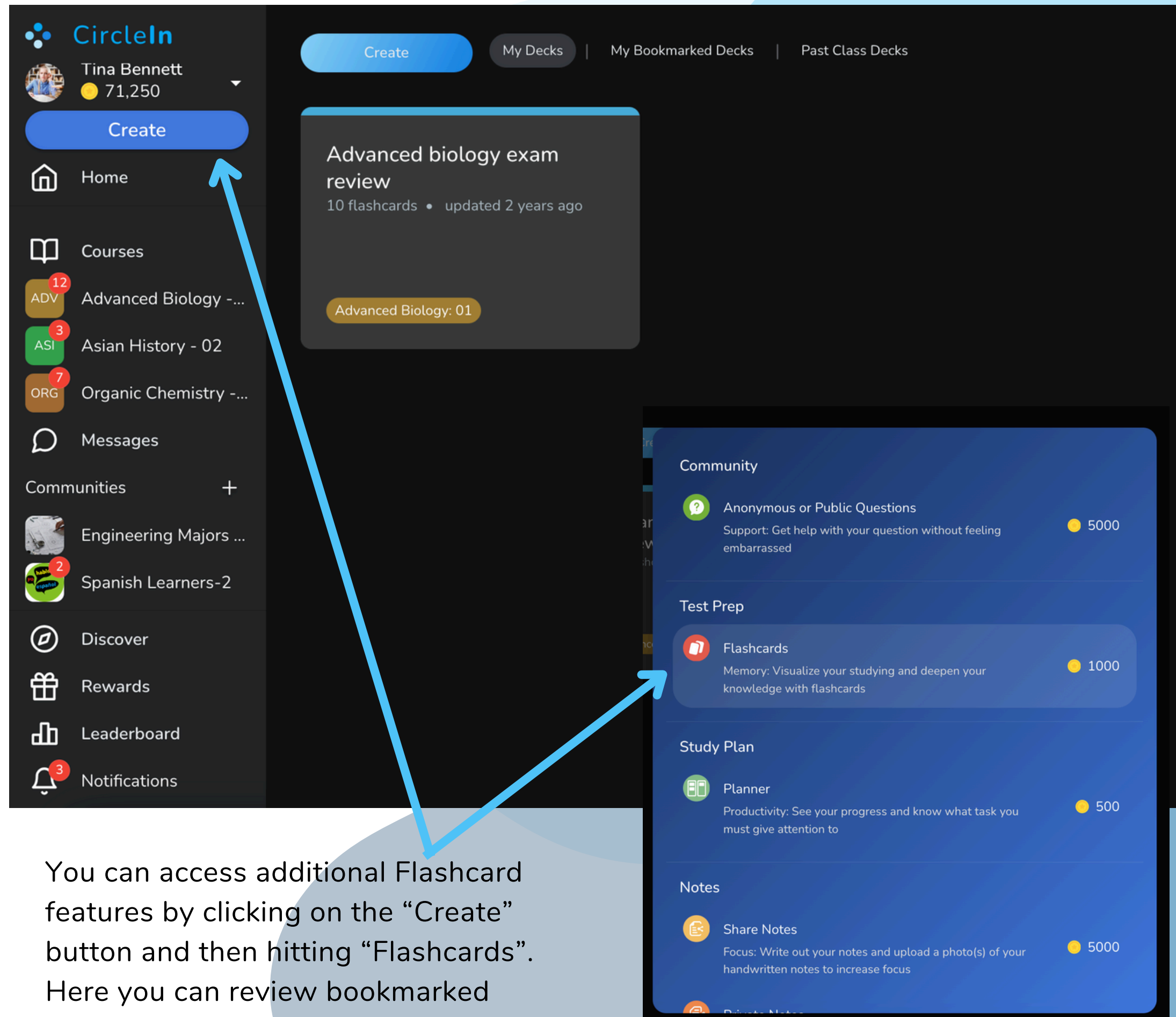
When the time comes to prepare for an exam, students are able to use the **Flashcard** feature to create study decks and review the material.

Students can then use **Practice Mode** and **Game Mode** to easily review their flashcard decks.

You can access additional Flashcard features by clicking on the “Create” button and then hitting “Flashcards”. Here you can review bookmarked decks and past classes.

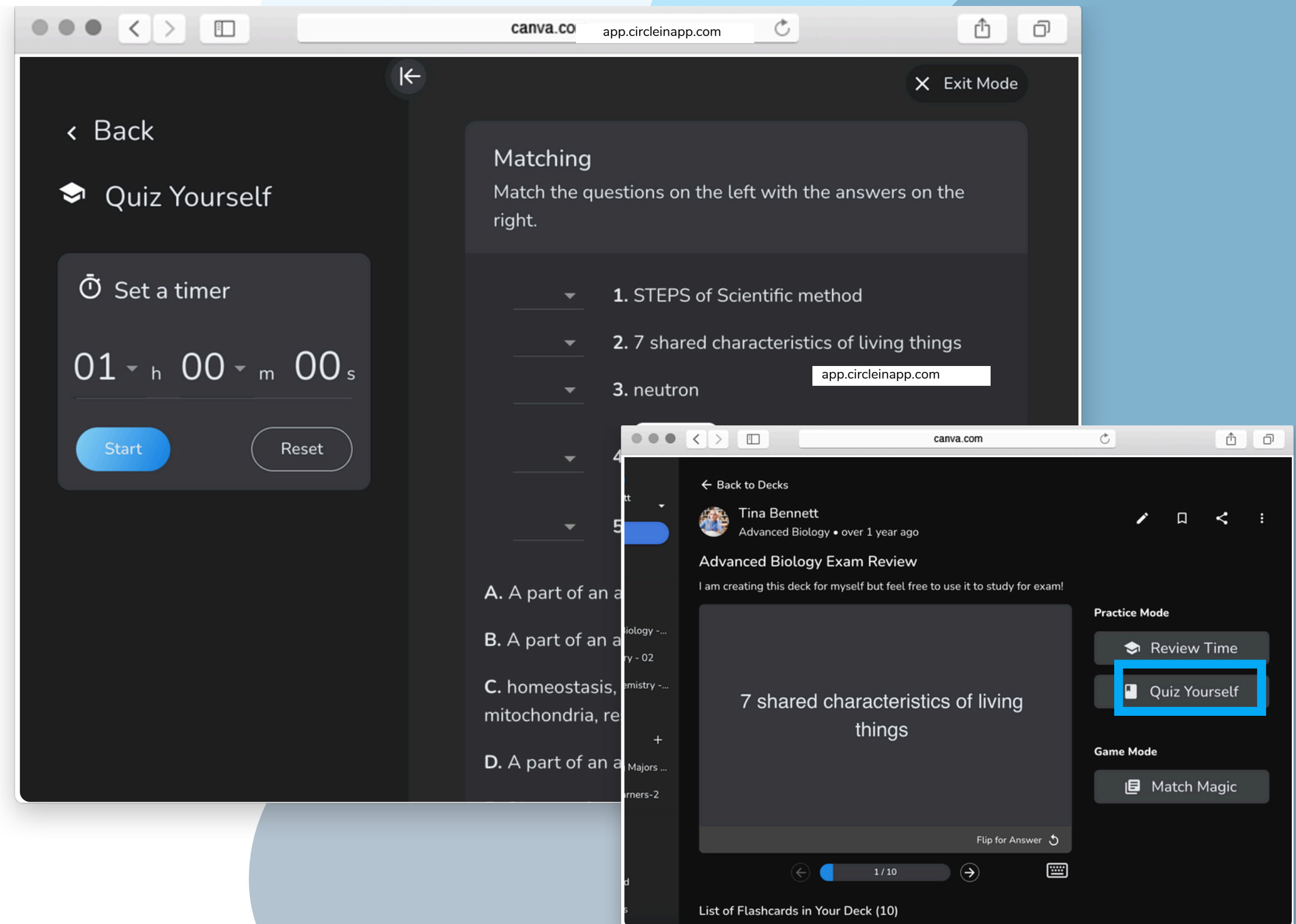


Flashcard Practice Modes

Quiz Yourself randomly generates a quiz of up to 20 questions. Students quiz themselves with a combination of **Matching** and **Multiple Choice**.

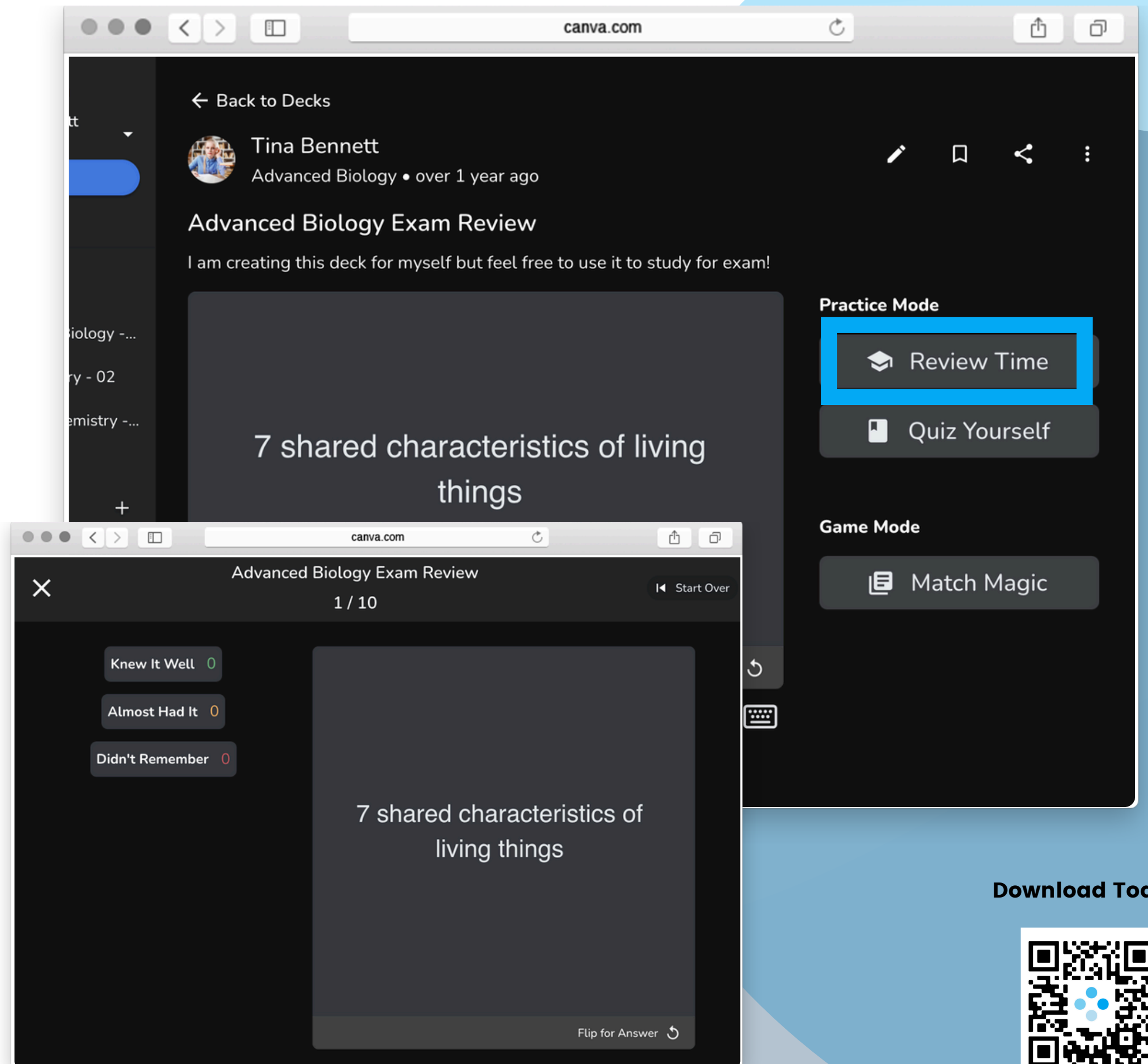
Students can see how well they know their stuff by clicking on “**Check your answers**” and the system **automatically grades** the quiz.

Review Time lets students review flashcards they have created to practice memorizing any terms or information they have added to their deck.

Students can self report if they "**Didn't Remember, Almost Had It, or Knew It Well**" so they can focus on practicing the terms they haven't mastered.

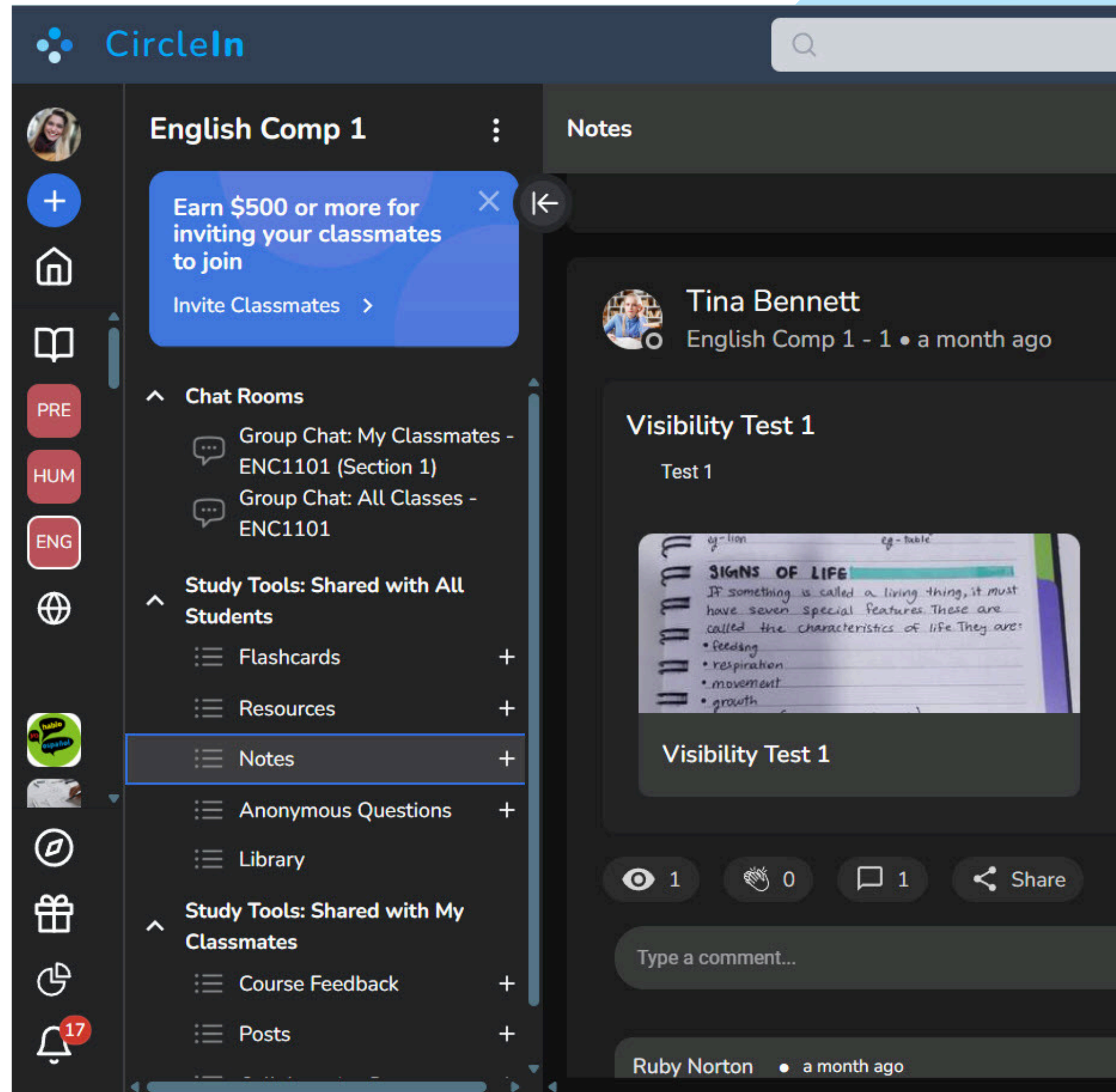

Content in this section is **only** shared with students in the same class section as you.



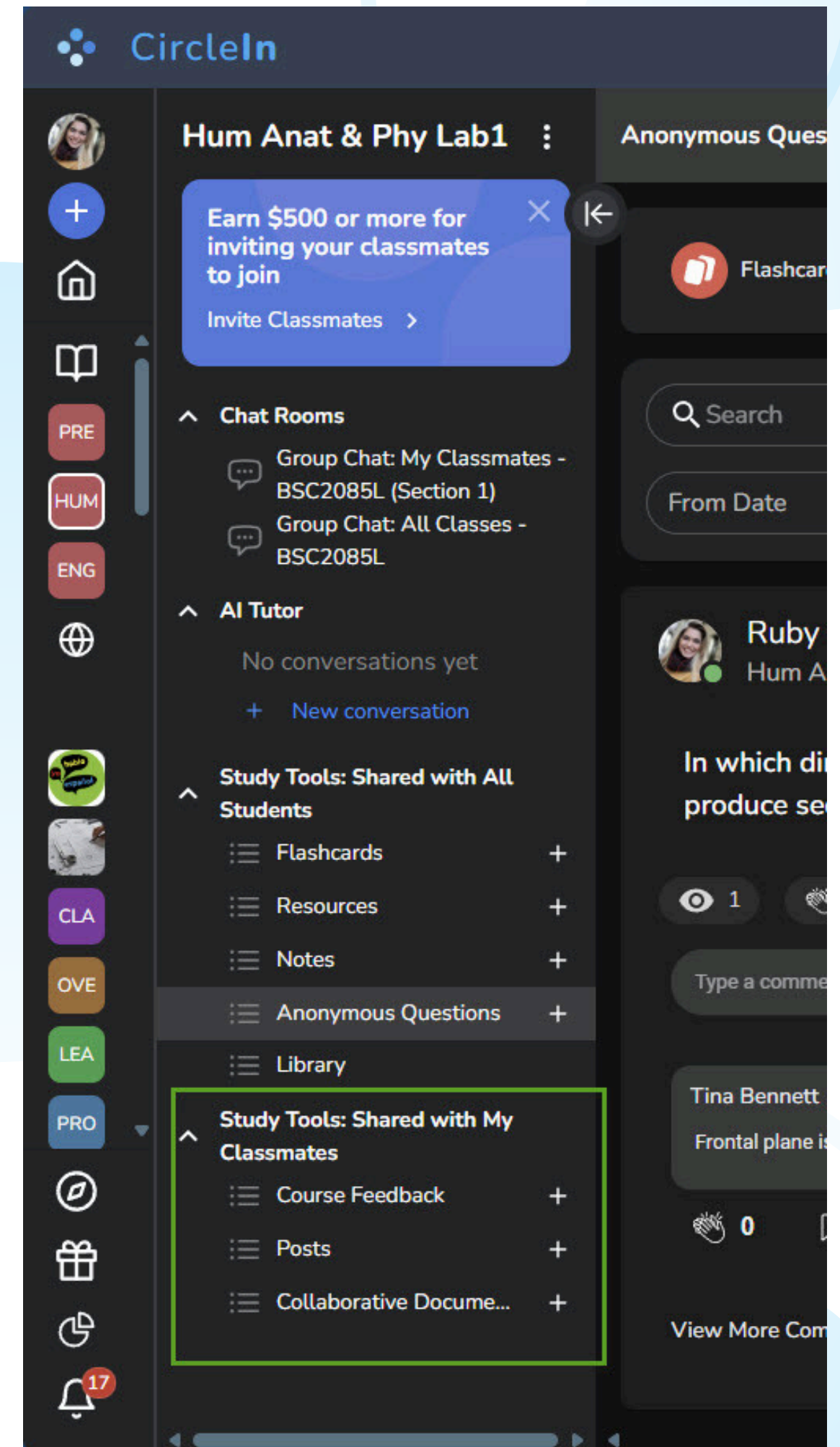
Course Feedback: Complete anonymous surveys to share where you're struggling. You may also reply to other students responses to offer help or solutions.



Write a Post: Share an announcement or message in your class. You can also use posts to share notes or items that you only want to share with your section.



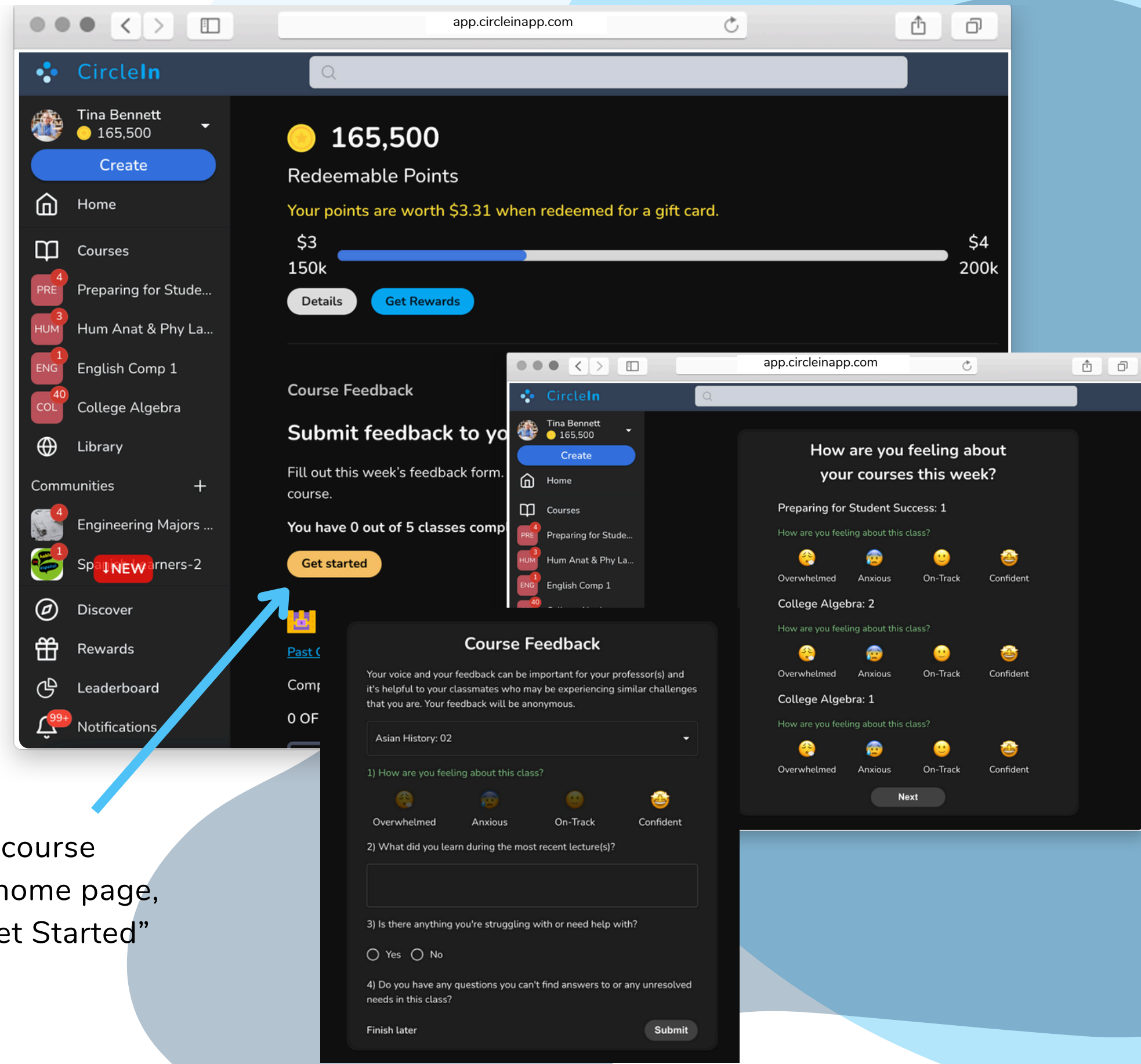

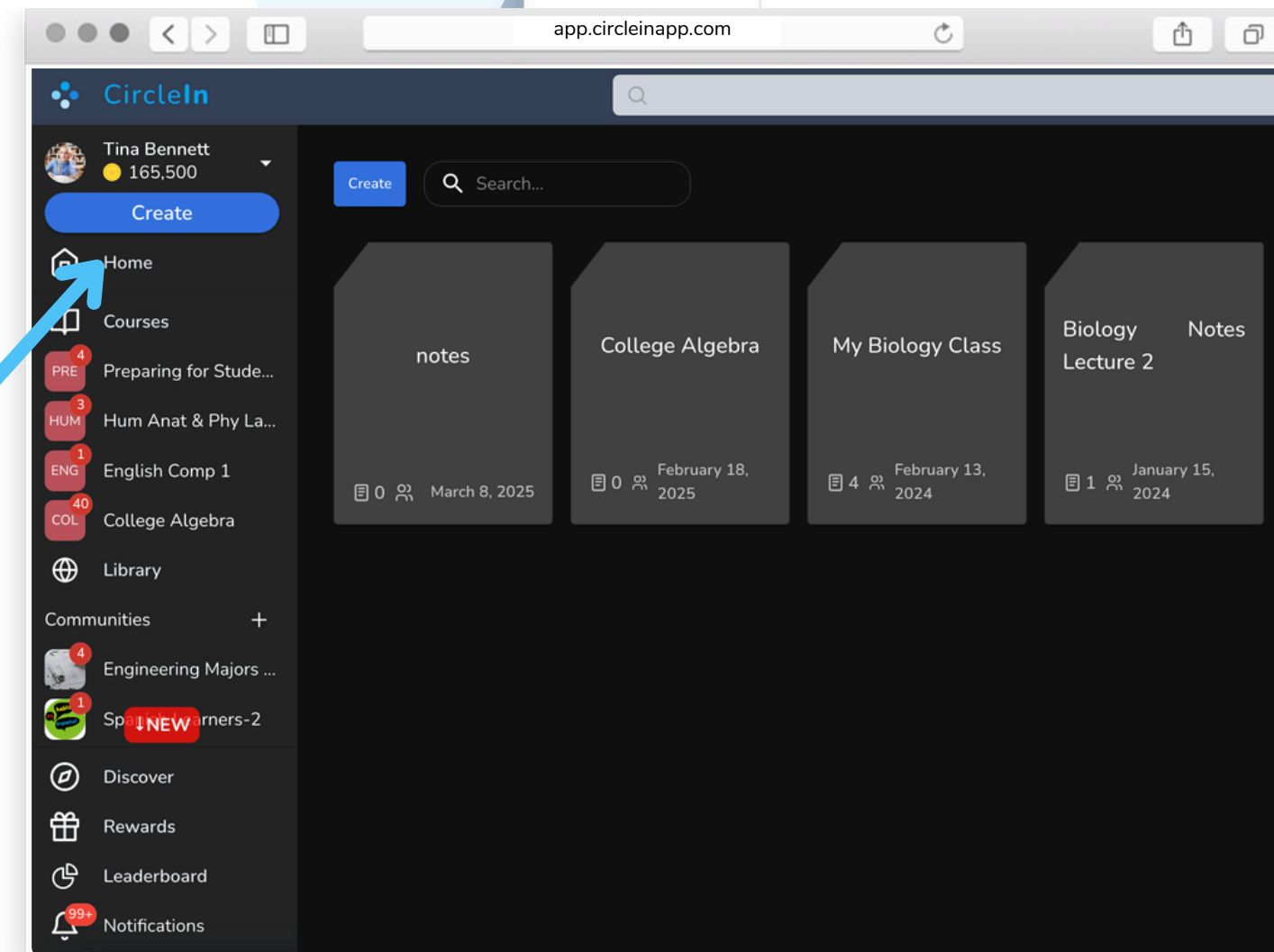
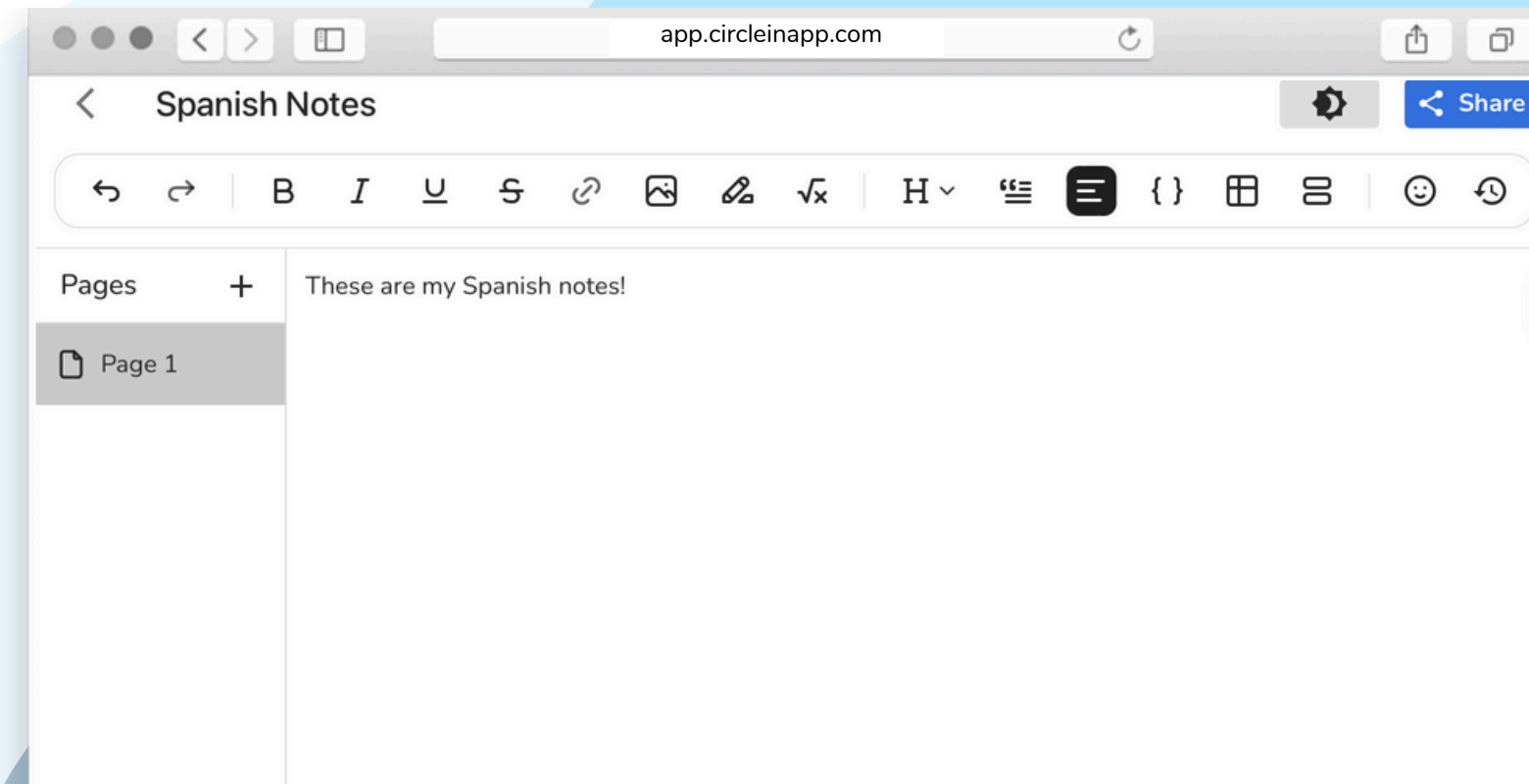
Collaborative Documents

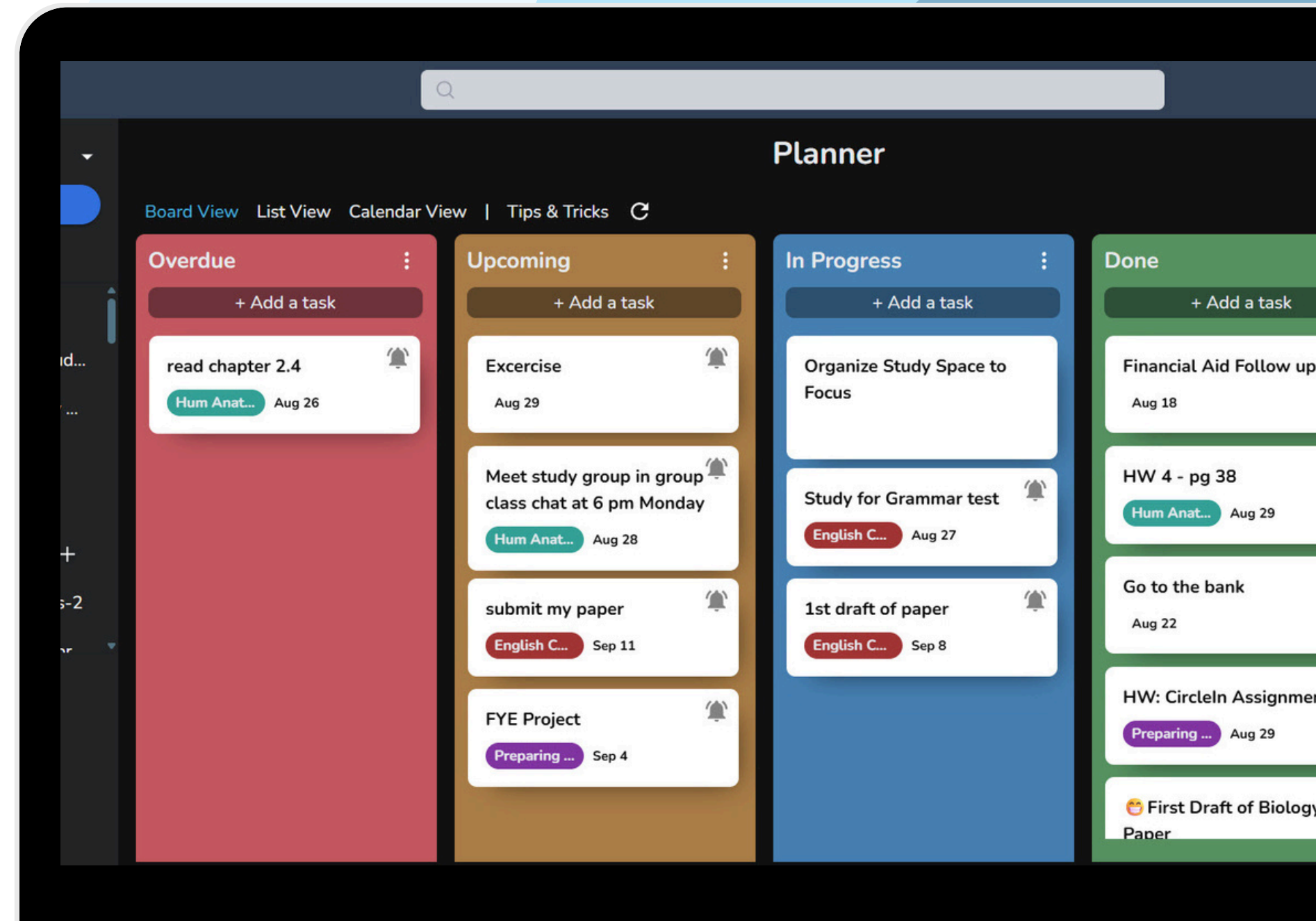


Get Organized with **Planner**

The planner is not shared with anyone but you.



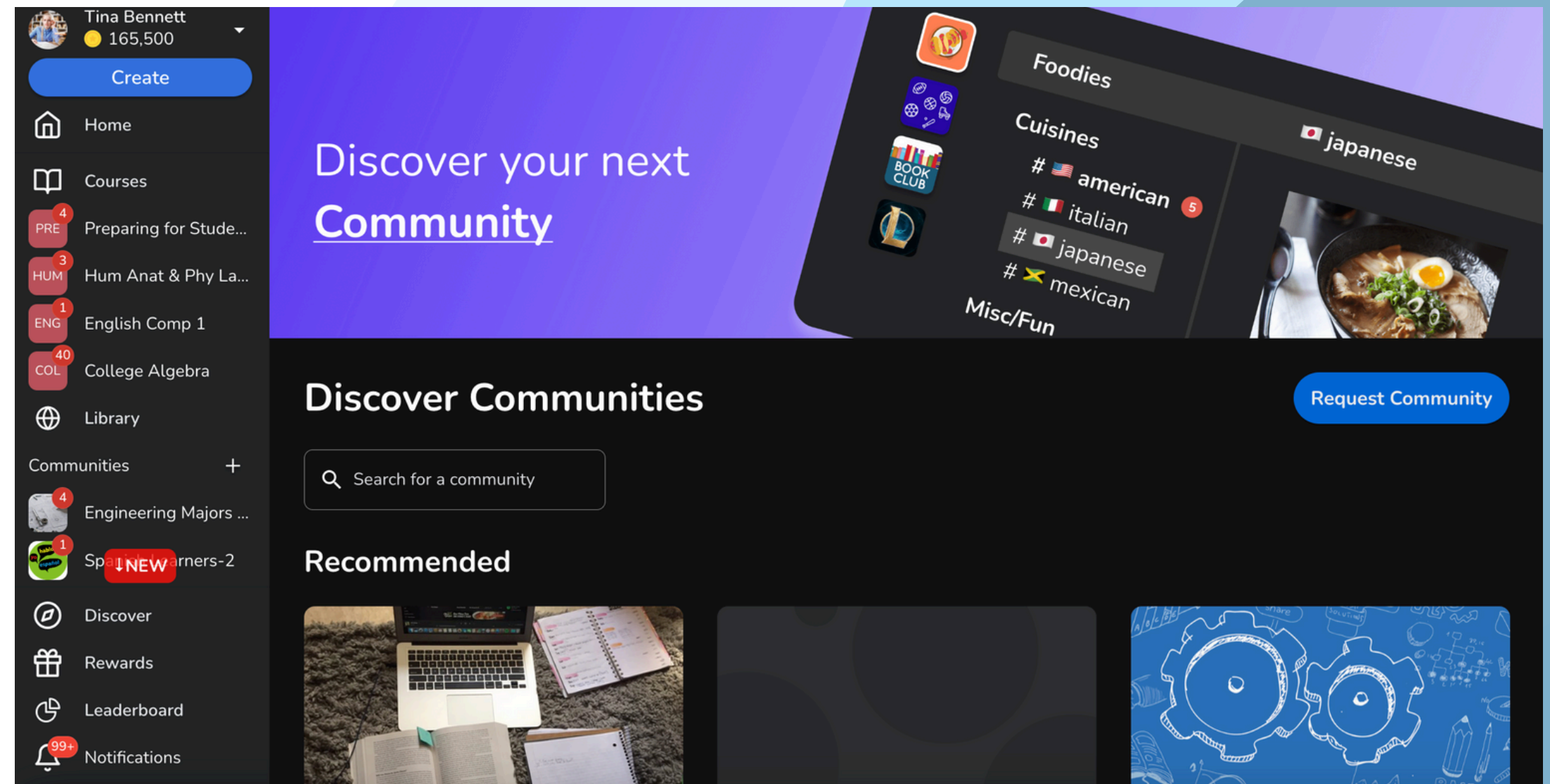

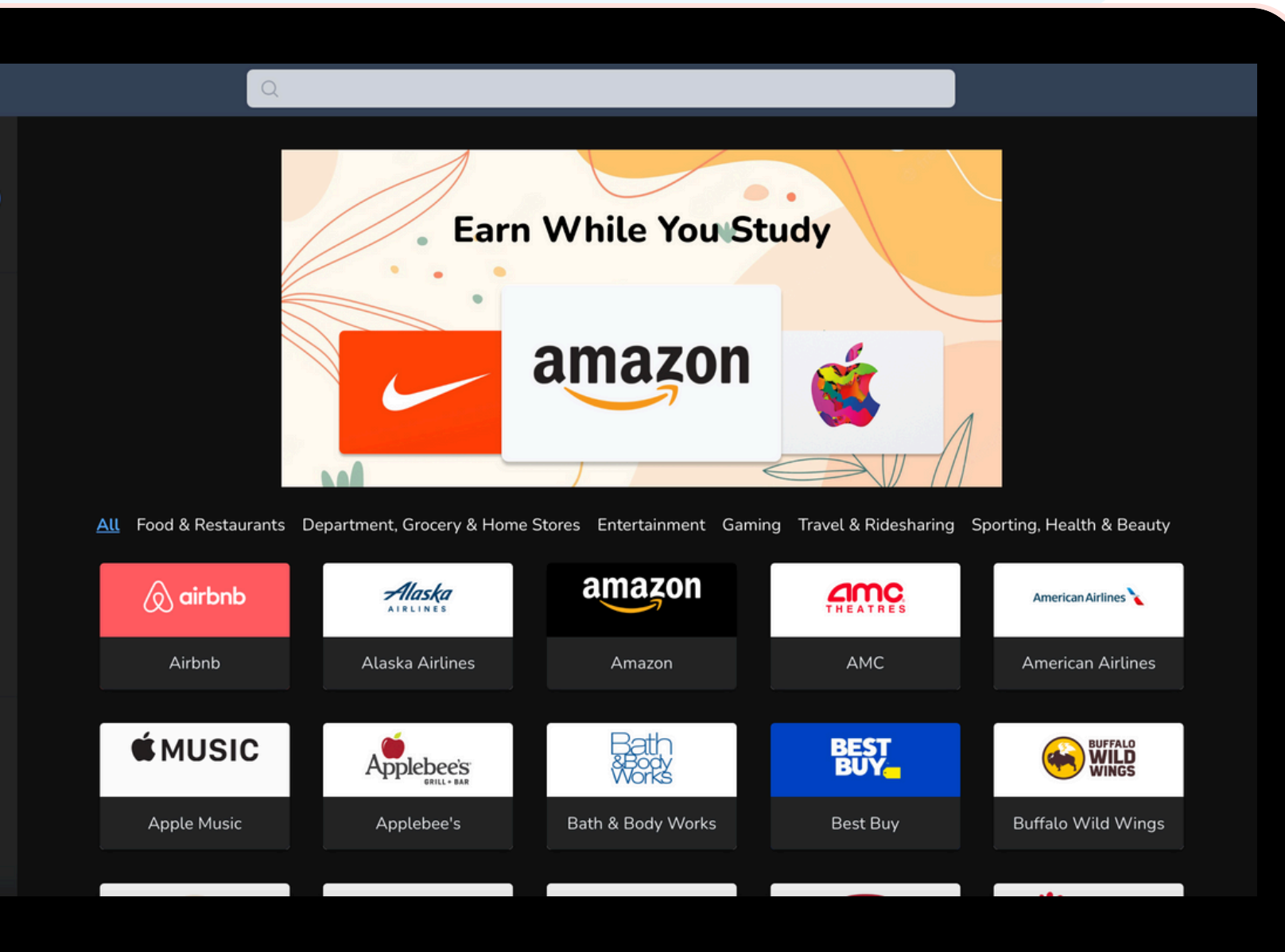
Communities
